Our leagues and bonspiels are organized and staffed by volunteers, much of the facility maintenance and operating work (e.g. ice-in, ice-out) is carried out by volunteers, and your conveners and board members are all volunteers. Without volunteers our Club could not operate. While this is necessary in part for financial reasons, volunteer involvement is the basis of our curling community and the social interactions that help make curling a truly rewarding activity.

Each year our Club makes a “**Volunteer of the Year**” award which recognizes service to the Club much beyond the normal. In the past, the award has gone to one person or to more than one in the same year, as the names on the “Volunteer” plaque in the downstairs lobby show. The award is administered by the Board, who are now asking for nominations.

ECC members can nominate any other member (or members) whom they deem worthy of the award. Nominations must include a brief description of why the person (or persons) is being nominated.

Nominations open on March 18, 2019 and must be submitted by April 22, 2019.

The list of nominees will be presented to the membership for a vote. Eventually the Award winner(s) will be announced at the AGM.
